A Letter from our Superintendent:

Dear Friends

I write this to you on the eve of Ascension day, the day that marks the moment Jesus literally ascended into heaven in front of his disciples, at the village of Bethany near Jerusalem. It was many years ago now as a child that I can remember singing in the Roger Jones musical 'Saints Alive' - 1983 in fact. It told the story of the birth of the church on the day of Pentecost showing the dramatic change which took place in the apostles, turning them from frightened and hopeless men to people who turned the world upside down. The words that resonate and still stay with me – "why stand there gazing into heaven, fear on your faces all alone, Jesus will come to you, and you'll know his word is true, he said he'd never leave you on your own" For me that powerful image of disciples looking upwards, afraid wondering what comes next, when of course with hindsight we know what comes next; the most amazing advocate the Holy Spirit, earth-shaking, motivating, transforming spirit, to enter us, change us and lead us on.
