A Letter from our Superintendent:

Dear Friends

As we move through the seasons of the year we find ourselves now preparing to observe the holy season of Lent. We do this by prayer, self-denial and charitable giving, self-examination and repentance and by reading and meditating on God's word. As you look through this Plan and see the services and activities that the individual churches have organised within their own communities, you will see a richness of opportunities to commit yourself to those principles. Lent is a journey, a journey to the cross, a journey that we hope will change and transform us anew.

One of the things that the Methodist church is requesting of all ministers, local preachers and stewards, is that they undertake Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion training. This is done in the hope the church today may be a more welcoming and inclusive place for everyone. It should not matter what you look like or sound like, or whether we hold different views and opinions from each other. The Methodist church prides itself that it holds within its family, a community of believers with contradictory views. This year for Christian unity week the theme was 'Be – longing' and we were reminded that it was 30 years since the murder of Stephen Lawrence. We have been focusing on how, together, we can contribute to the promotion of racial justice, but more than that, justice for all.

As part of the training, I led a session on Difference and we looked at how a tapestry is made. The beautiful picture that is created at the front but the often-messy strands of the cords at the back, this often reflects our life. Paul and I, on our recent visit to the Holy land, went to a young woman's fair-trade initiative in Turkey where they were making many such tapestries. The women from local villages were, paid a fair wage and provided with looms. They could, therefore provide for their families and not have to be sold to older men into marriage, which had been the principle before. The thing we hadn't realised was that the beautiful tapestry takes up to 9 months to make by hand and often two or three women from the same family would each take a turn when one got tired. Thus, not only sharing the load and the chores of the family, but being enabled to stay together as a family unit.
